## Rules for the Equestrian Classes

1. The Judges' decision is final in all matters without stating a reason. Any objection must be put in writing and lodged with the secretary, together with a deposit of £20, within 15 minutes of close of a class.
2. Entries taken on the field unless specified.
3. All ages taken on the day of the show unless specified.
4. The schedule will run as printed unless exceptional circumstances prevail, when any alteration will be at the sole discretion of the committee.
5. Every endeavor has been made to avoid classes clashing however, competitors are reminded to consider any possible clashes before entering
6. Hard hats must be to the one of the following standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) or VG1 01.040 (2014-12) or ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) or SNELL E2001 or E2016 AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and are to be worn at all times when mounted.
7. No entry fee will be refunded.
8. 8. Due to the loss of several trophies over the last few years, a deposit of £20 will be required for all trophies. This will be refunded on the safe receipt of
9. the trophy for the next year's show.
10. Horse/ponies competing in novice classes should not have won a first prize in an open class before January of the current year.

#### Limited Entries & no entries on the day

Two teams going head to head in a knock out competition, the fastest teams (taking into account poles knocked down, adding 4 seconds) will automatically go on to the second round, in the event of an odd number going through another team will also go through (on fastest time), the teams that get knocked out in the round will be first back in the ring to jump off for positions. The winning teams will continue through the rounds to the final.

A baton will be provided for each team – a regular size whip (they are matching!).

Once in the ring the starter will do a coin toss to pick sides.

There will be a prize for the best presented/matching team.

Teams will be given colours (can be requested), hat markers or similar will be provided, but if teams chose to wear matching tops/numbers etc please feel free.

The courses will consist of 6 jumps, in a mirror image of each other.

Times will NOT be accumulative, each time you enter the ring both teams will start afresh.

Max height 85cm , no entry restrictions apply.

Fastest team will advance to the next round, however any poles knocked down will add 4seconds to the time.

Times or faults will not be carried forwards to the next round.

In the event of refusals (or a fall, provided horse and rider are fine) a team member may be rescued by another team member, they must take the baton and complete the rest of the round and then complete their own if they have not yet done so.

Teams of 3 can compete, one member will be required to jump twice, having exchanged the baton between rounds.

Individuals or part teams please get in contact for the possibility of forming a team.

Class 12 **Concours d'Elegance Seniors** Riders to be 16 years of age or *over*. Costumes or traditional allowed, to be judged on the overall picture of elegance.
