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VEGETABLE CLASSES

- Class 1 Cabbage, 1 head, 1 variety
- Class 2 Runner Beans: 6 pods of the same variety and size
- Class 3 One green runner bean – longest
- Class 4 Herbs: 3 different herbs in vase, labelled
- Class 5 Carrots: 5 of same variety and size. Tops not to exceed 10cm
- Class 6 Cucumber: one, any variety
- Class 7 Tomatoes: 5 on a stalk, same variety and size
- Class 8 2 marrows, not to exceed 12ins
- Class 9 Potatoes: white 4 tubers
- Class 10 Potatoes: coloured, 4 tubers
- Class 11 Parsnips: 3 with tops, not to exceed 10cms
- Class 12 Onions: 6 large, one variety, any colour
- Class 13 Beetroot: 3 tops cut to 10cms
- Class 14 A pair of vegetables not named in the schedule



FLOWER CLASSES

All exhibits to be grown by competitor

- Class 15 Gladiolus: 1 spike
- Class 16 A foliage pot plant max. pot size 20cms/8ins
- Class 17 A bowl of 6 large flowered roses, 1 or more varieties
- Class 18 3 medium dahlias
- Class 19 A collection of flowers (max. 9 blooms)
- Class 20 1 bowl sweet peas: 12 stems
- Class 21 Coleus

Rules

1. The judges decision is final
2. All produce must be home grown/made
3. All items to be presented as requested.
4. Points awarded as follows; 1st place = 5pts, 2nd place = 3pts, 3rd place = 1pt.
5. A special certificate and trophy will be awarded to the adult and child (under 16) with the highest overall points on the day.
6. A special certificate will be awarded to the overall 'Best in Show' exhibit.
7. Entry fee: 50p per item. Entry on the day of the show before 10:00am.
8. Judging will take place between 10:30 and 12:00pm. Show open to the public at 12:30pm.
9. Presentations for floral art and produce will take place at 4:30pm in the flower marquee.
